COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES April 1, 2014

The Community Development Committee meeting was called to order at 9:30 AM.

Present: Chairman/Trustee Charlotte Hollenbach, Trustees David Kielpinski and Ramsin Wardanian.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the March 20, 2014 committee meeting were reviewed.

Trustee Kielpinski moved, seconded by Trustee Hollenbach to approve the March 20, 2014 minutes as presented. Motion approved by voice vote.

Unfinished Business: The Committee briefly discussion the Richmond Fine Art Festival. It was noted that one individual has applied. The Clerk confirmed that Prairieland Disposal is getting six port-a-lets and two sinks at no cost to the Village for the event. The Committee asked that they be placed behind Memorial Hall on Friday, June 27th before 2:00 PM. The Clerk was asked to contact Cathy Contri, a local Spring Grove artist that inquired about the event to see if she was interested in participating. Trustee Kielpinski will be speaking with Tom Jiaras regarding donation of water.

The Committee discussed that they wanted (4) Bike Racks and (4) Benches, the Village will pay for the plaques. It was suggested that the Clerk contact Frontier to see if they would be interested in donating a bench for Memorial Hall. The Clerk asked for a photograph of the type of bench/bike racks residents or businesses could purchase with the cost to include the information in the next Village newsletter.

Trustee Kielpinski mentioned the email sent by President Koenig regarding Chicago businesses. The Clerk reported that she had forward it on to Joyce McArdle. Trustee Kielpinski also reported that a presentation will be held at MCC on May 15, 2014 at 7:30 AM regarding the Foreign Trade Zone. There was a brief discussion pertaining to the Mudder events to be held at the Richmond Hunt Club in May of 2014.
