Minutes from previous meeting, July 6, 2015 and minutes from 2 oral interview sessions Part I on July 31, 2015 and Part II on August 1, 2015 were reviewed and approved.

The Police Board of Commissioners met to review the final Eligibility Register, to be posted in September, containing 2015 applicants that have attained a final score of 90% and list of applicants that remain from the 2014 list.

- an offer to hire one full time officer from the list, completed by Chief Cetrangolo
- an offer to hire two part-time officers from the list, completed by the Chief.

Unanimous agreement and recommendation to hire 2 retired "lateral hire" officers that were interviewed 7/31/15. The Board agrees to waive the entry level written examination for both laterals. The remaining portion of the testing process will administered by chief, to include background check and psychological evaluation.

New Business: The Board and Chief agree that establishing a Boys Scout Explorer/ Police Cadet Corps has the possibility of encouraging teens (boys and girls) into careers in Law Enforcement. The Chief will contact Scout Troop Leaders in Richmond and Spring Grove and any representative in R-B High School.
