Approval of Minutes:

Commissioners have reviewed and approved these minutes, electronically, before distribution.

The Police Board of Commissioners and Richmond Chief of Police met to discuss plans for the police entrance examination that will be given on Saturday, October 11, 2014 at Richmond-Burton High School.

The physical portion will begin at 1 pm on the outdoor track (weather permitting).

The written exam will be given, directly after the physical, at 2 pm in an assigned room in the high school.

The test is advertised with the instructions for applications to be picked-up, completed and returned to the Village Hall by October 3, 2014. Each applicant will pay \$30.00 fee to the Village Clerk to offset the expense of the exam.

The Board will request a Richmond Fire ambulance to be present and stand-by during the physical portion of the examination.

The final results of the entire examination process will be merged with the existing eligibility list that is posted and is scheduled to expire in September 2015.

Upon completion of the process, the Commission hopes that the Village of Richmond will bring the staff to a recommended level of four full time officers.
