The Police Board of Commissioners met to approve the final Eligibility Register and to present the list of potential police candidates to Chief Cetrangolo. The Chief will post the list, and it will remain posted until September 2017 or as instructed by the Police Commission. The Chief stated that candidate #1 from the list, will begin the police academy, Monday 9/28/15 and will finish in about 6 months. Candidate number 2, 3, and 4 will have their background checked. Starting two of the three in the "Part-Time" academy, that takes about 9 months to complete.

General items in the budget were discussed: Purchasing vehicles vs. Leasing, the Chief thinks more advantageous to purchase because the average annual mileage is 30,000. Salary adjustments and equipment purchases required to maintain efficiency and safety.

New Business:

Commissioner Elliott proposed that the Police Board budget be increased by \$1,000.00 annually to compensate the commissioners for random monthly and periodic weekend meetings and provide \$100.00 for operating supplies, paper, copy machine ink, files etc.
