Approval of previous minutes, reviewed and approved via email 8/30/14.

Location: Richmond-Burton High School ...outdoor track, gym and classroom.

The Police Commission met, and with Chief Cetrangolo, conducted the three phases of the examination that will establish an eligibility list that will be combined/merged with the current list. The new list will be used to hire 2 full time police officers.

The test began with a 1.5 mile run around the outdoor oval track. Part two of the exam consisted of the physical fitness, established and recommended by the State of Illinois, It is known as the "power test". It includes the sit and reach, sit-ups, and bench press, all per the Power Chart.

Upon completion of the power test, the 19 applicants then completed the written portion of the examination in the classroom. As the applicants exited, each person was given a "hand-out" that explained the test process and what to expect next, the oral interview etc.

All Police Commissioners and Chief Cetrangolo corrected the written exams, then decided to conduct the oral interviews in the Village Hall on Friday October 24, 2014 between the hours of 1pm to 4pm. A second group will be interviewed Saturday October 25, 2014 between 1pm and 6pm. The Chief will notify each candidate with the information regarding the oral interviews.

The Commissioners decided to attend the Finance Committee meeting on 10/14/14 and then the full Board of Trustees meeting on 10/16/14 to make a presentation and to obtain Board approval to hire 2 full time police officers.
