

## Monitoring Violations Annual Notice

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

#### Monitoring Requirements Not Met for RICHMOND IL1110750

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 7-1-25 through 12-31-25, we did not monitor or test in the required timeframe for PH and alkalinity and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time. Samples were taken before testing period began which did not satisfy the violation per IEPA rules. A re-sample was taken and this notice produced in order to comply with IEPA requirements.*

#### What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for PH and alkalinity, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When all samples should have been taken	When samples were or will be taken
PH	Upon trigger level	6	7/1/25 – 12/31/25	3/19/25 – 5/1/25, re-sample 3/12/26
Alkalinity	Upon trigger level	6	7/1/25 – 12/31/25	3/19/25 – 5/1/25, re-sample 3/12/26

Re-samples were submitted at appropriate timeframe and public notice available to all water customers.
