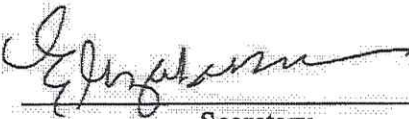

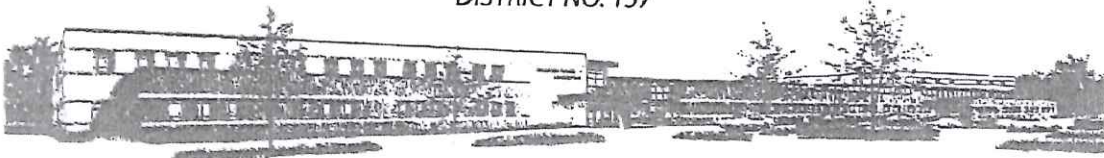

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 2 Board of Trustees, Section 2.07 Order of Business of the Richmond Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Richmond, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 2.07, Order of Business of the Richmond Municipal Code shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
